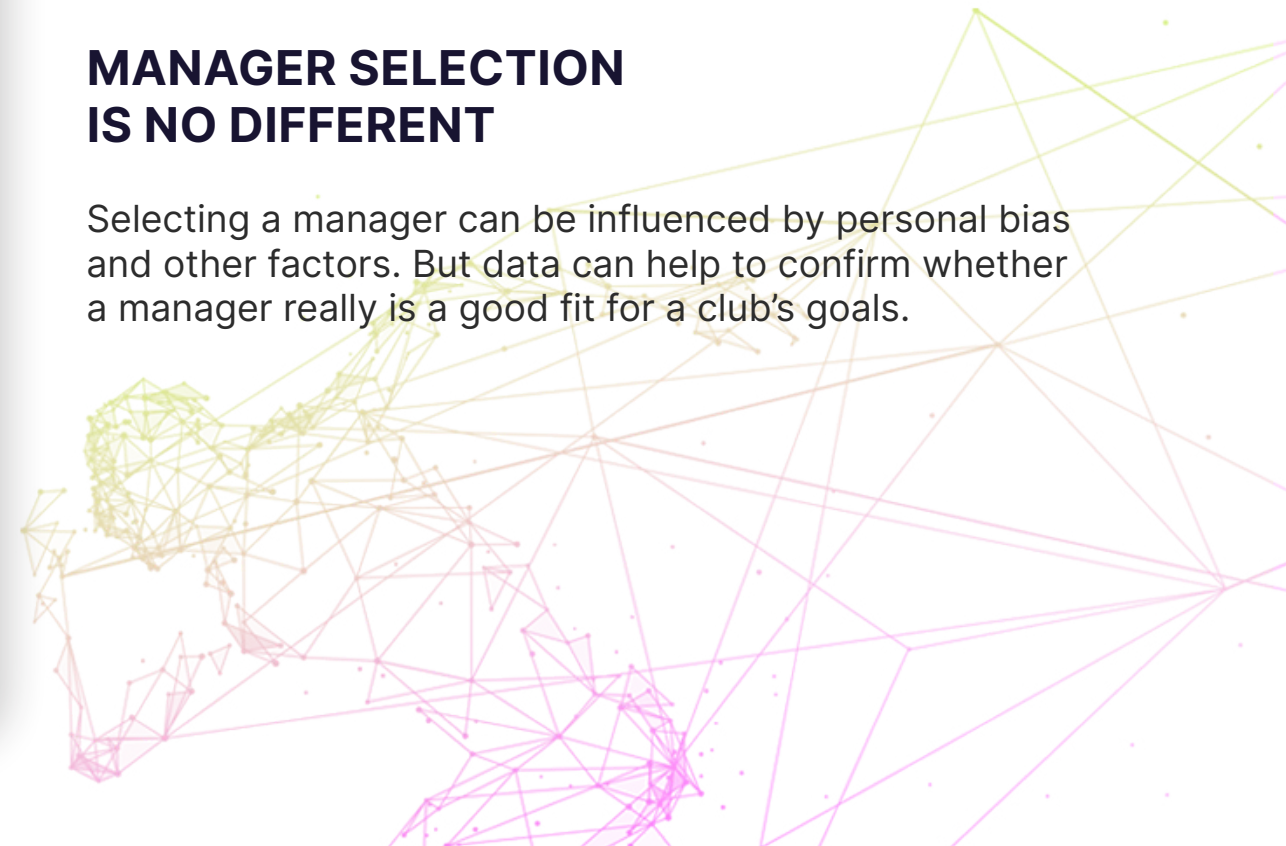


TEAMS ARE ALREADY TAKING ADVANTAGE OF IT

4 | Head Coach Analysis: Overview

WHAT DOES IT DO?

The tool ranks Head Coaches by their performances across all the clubs they have managed.

This can be looked at across different time periods, along with a variety of other filters, to see a listing of the best coaches who meet your chosen criteria.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

We are constantly monitoring clubs and their performances with our proprietary software. We then cross reference this performance ranking with head coaches and their tenure at different clubs.

The underlying principle is simple

If a coach is consistently improving results and performance upon arriving at a range of different clubs, then they must be doing something right.

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MANAGER PERFORMANCE

Gives a range of filters (nationality, contract length, age, average team improvement) to refine the search by coach suitability and performance.

DEEP DIVE

Once a shortlist is identified, we do a deep dive into specific managers to assess club performance before, during and after their tenure to truly identify their effect at the club.

RANGE OF DATA

We have a huge range of managers in our database, over 10,000 at the last count, giving great scope to find value and impartially assess performance.

PROPRIETARY ALGORITHM

All this analysis is underpinned by our unique football algorithm, which tracks teams performance across the world.

6 | Head Coach Analysis: Deep Dives

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DEEP DIVE

Once a shortlist has been identified we do a series of deeper analysis on the identified coaches, looking at their performances at clubs, but encompassing a time period of 6 months prior to their joining and 6 months after their leaving, to truly break down the effect of their tenure at the club.

IMPARTIAL DECISION MAKING

This enhanced due diligence can be distributed amongst all the relevant decision makers in the club, to allow them the opportunity to assess all the candidates and discuss their merits with full access to all the same information, free from bias.
