Liverpool FC have a team of data analysts (including a physicist from CERN) and work with Google's DeepMind to analyze for patterns in how their opponents play.

Manchester City have a similar data set up and have bespoke apps to analyze training sessions and record player level data.

**HOW DOES IT WORK?** We are constantly monitoring clubs performance in leagues across the world, running simulations of the entire season to assess the likelihood of all outcomes.

# Season Analysis: Key Features

**TARGET ANALYSIS:** Breaks the season into blocks and shows how many points ahead or behind target you are, as well as what matches are required to hit your target.

**NORMALISED LEAGUE TABLES:** Shows an alternate league table, adjusted for match difficulty and games in hand, to show a more realistic assessment of how each team in the league is performing.

**SEASON CHANCES:** Shows probability of promotion, playoffs, midtable and relegation, and how these have moved over time, allowing you to assess how you stand relative to your season aims.

**RIVAL ANALYSIS:** Shows your rivals and their upcoming matches and chances. This gives an indication of how they may be approaching the season as well as the importance of these head to heads.



Season Analysis - Overview

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SEASON TARGET

Sunderland have set a target of finishing 6th and making the playoffs.

REQUIREMENTS

The model estimates this to require - on average - around 75 points based on 10,000 simulations of the league.

CURRENT CHANCES

It indicates that Sunderland currently have around a 3% of achieving their target position or above.

SEASON CHANCES

Sunderland are currently on 47 points, so require around 28 points from their remaining 13 matches, which is about 10 wins.

The table below shows how many of these points are required from each block ("Target Pts" under "Upcoming"). The individual block pages will then show the specific matches to target that the model indicates are likely to give you the best chance of winning those points.

OVERALL SEASON TARGET

Shown here is overall season target position set with your team at the start of the season.

The model has estimated the number of points required to hit this target position and shows the current likelihood of achieving it.

Also shown is the updated target for the remaining matches. This is updated and recalculated on a weekly basis after each round of matches.

SEASON ANALYSIS - BLOCKS

The table to the right shows the season broken up into 6 (roughly) equal blocks of matches.

Each block is split into upcoming and completed matches and shows the target number of points required in order to hit your overall season target.

This target will change depending on actual results so it may be different from week to week.

The actual points won from completed matches is also shown, along an assessment of how each period is progressing relative to target.
